



Description:

Vermouth 700 – the first Krauss Vermouth created in cooperation with Gut Moser in Leutschach.

Vermouth is a flavoured wine, which reaches a higher alcohol content once neutral alcohol is added.

Creativity can be given free rein when it comes to flavouring, but the wormwood herb that gives it its name must always play a role.

We wanted to keep it simple here, as with the gins, which usually only contain 3-6 main botanicals. And yet a special note had to be included. That is why we have not only added neutral alcohol to the flavoured wine but also our G+ Oak Cask Gin.

This gin harmonises perfectly with the wine and gives it slightly woody, vanilla notes.

The wine for our Vermouth 700 is a Sauvignon Blanc. This comes from Gut Moser, the highest winery in Austria at 700m
